Thank you for signing up to be part of Arura 2010. You are part of a group of over 180 adults and 250 young people! It's shaping up to be another fantastic camp. Together, we have much work to do, many things to learn and much fun to have as we create super memories of Summer 2010.

This letter should provide you with the final information you need, in addition to your handbook. Read it carefully and, if you've any questions, contact either myself, or the Arura office.

Venue:

We are staying at Limavady Grammar School, 3 Ballyquin Road, Limavady, Co. Londonderry, BT49 9ET

Final Payment:

If you haven't fully paid for Arura, please pass on the balance of payments to your leader or the Arura Office **asap**. If you can't remember how much you have paid already, contact the Arura Office. Remember camp costs £135 per person or £120 per person if more than one is going from the same household.

We are most grateful for your contribution towards the costs of Arura and ensuring that the camp fee for the young people is not burdened by the cost of all of us adults too.

Saturday 24th July:

Transport has been arranged for everyone travelling to Arura.

Depending on your associated Rally or church meet at the following pick up points. If you're not in a Rally and wish to avail of transport to Limavady, please let the Arura office know **asap** which pick up you wish to use.

We would prefer workers not to bring their own cars to the school. For those workers who, out of necessity, are bringing their own transport, please plan to be on site by 12.00 noon on 24th to help with final preparations and registration. What you need:

Accommodation at Arura will be dormitory style, with limited space and storage virtually non-existent, so please don't bring more than you need. Here are a few things that you will definitely need:

- Towel, toiletries & sun cream(!)
- Sleeping bag & pillow with pillow case
- Waterproof coat
- Sports gear
- Small rucksack / bag for day trips
- Swimming gear
- Strong walking shoes
- Old clothes for arts & crafts / wet activities
- Wet suit (if you have one)
- Whether you are in a Rally or not, you **WON'T** need your uniform
- Your leaders /workers handbook
- Any clothing /equipment suitable to the particular role you will be undertaking

Special Requirements:

Workers will be needed to supervise a whole variety of fun activities for campers on the first night. Please bring something to dress up in, so that you will stand out from the crowd. It could be a whole clown's outfit or a wetsuit or maybe just a fluorescent shirt or a big wig and shades. Use your imagination – but bring something! The participation of workers will also be needed in Arura's Got Talent, so please come prepared with some ideas for something that you or you and your friends could do on the night – and also any equipment or clothing that you might need. It could be a bit of stand-up, a sketch, a song and dance routine, a poem, whatever – but it's your chance to be the next Diversity, Susan Boyle or Spellbound!

Medication or Other Special Needs:

Medical staff will be on duty throughout Arura for minor ailments and for dispensing regular medication. If you have not informed us of, or there has been a recent change to, your medical details or special dietary needs, please provide full instructions to Ruth Ewing via the Arura office by 16th July.

Visitors:

This year, we are not inviting parents or supporters of Arura to the Mass Exodus outing on the Wednesday. This is because it's a long way to Donegal for a day(!) and we will not be hosting an evening worship time in a larger venue to accommodate an increase in numbers. However, visitors will be allowed during the week and will be expected to follow our procedures (wearing visitors passes, etc.). No meals will be provided to visitors unless by prior arrangement. Under 18s will not be allowed to visit the Arura campus without their parents and will not be able to participate in any activities.

It is important that you plan to remain on site after the campers leave to clean and clear the school. We aim to be clear of the site by 5pm.
